### **Method of Selection**

1. Applicants will submit their application, transcript and their essay by the deadline.
2. All entries will be reviewed and scored by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
3. The applicants that are selected to receive the scholarship awards will be chosen based on their ability to adhere to the selection criteria.

### **Jokes and Justice Scholarship Selection Criteria**

1. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
2. The applicant must be of good character.
3. The applicant must have a 2.5 G.P.A.
4. The applicant must submit a high school transcript.
5. The applicant must submit a completed copy of the Scholarship Award application.
6. The applicant must submit an essay. The essay must be a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words. It should be a typed and double-spaced essay, typed in 12 pt. Times New Roman font. The essay must address the essay prompt.

### **2019 Essay Prompt**

Our country is divided in its opinion about the issue of illegal immigration and whether illegal immigrants should be deported or given a pathway to citizenship. Explain your views regarding this issue.

### **Essay Evaluation**

The essay will be scored based on the mechanics, style, and the content of the essay. The essay should address the prompt, be clearly written and well organized, and allow the reader to get to know the applicant better.

### **Deadline**
